Willapa Bay and Grays Harbor are directly above the Columbia River, a scientifically documented feeding location for the critically endangered Southern Resident killer whales; we have few of them left. The salmon and food source situation is not helping. Imidacloprid is a systemic insecticide that acts as an neurotoxin -- (Imidacloprid kills everything at the bottom of the food chain). I hardly think this is the best option to control burrowing shrimp on our ecology, our US wildlife, and our own food chain. Thank you.
