Our region is the only one in the nation that has not designated No Discharge Zones for any waters. Puget Sound needs this type of protection, too. I fully support Department of Ecology's determination and proposal to establish the Puget Sound No Discharge Zone.

This simple and common sense approach will protect public health, keep our waters clean, protect sensitive marine waters, and support important shellfish harvesting areas.

Fortunately, over 97% of boaters already do the right thing they have holding tanks onboard to store sewage (also called blackwater), and then pump it out using any one of the 100 designated pump-out facilities that are available throughout the Puget Sound.
