During the November 30, 2017 Work Shop you were asked if "an active construction site", Condition S12.B.3.c.i, included portable plants within a permitted surface mine. That is, the term construction site includes surface mines. You said no that surface mines were not considered construction sites. You were then asked how will you permit portable plants within permitted surface mines? You stated that portable plants within permitted surface mines would be permitted as they (portable plants) had been in the past. Please clarify that DOE will permit portable plants within permitted surface mines as they have in the past or that the term "construction sites" includes permitted surface mines.

The revised Form ECY 070-36, Item 12 should be removed from this form:

• Item 12. Amount of Recycled Concrete (Optional). While you stated, during the Work Shop, that this portion of the application was optional for us if we wanted to state the quantity. Recycled Concrete quantities are reported to DOE under the requirements of Chapter 173-350 WAC. The current S&GGP does not require recycled concrete quantities be reported within permit Section S12.B or elsewhere with in the permit.
