S4C pg. 12 "shall reduce the discharge of pollutants to the maximum extent practicable" (MEP). This is subjective. Could a measurable amount be specified; for example, add "and at a minimum, reduction of pollutants must meet TMDLs."

S4A pg. 11 "water quality standards" seems too non-specific.

Do subsequent references to "water quality standards" mean the WAC in S4B? pg. 12 such S4F1 and 2, pg. 12. Also S43ai and ii, pg. 13

S4F3D, pg. 14. "annual report". For how many years?

S5C3e, pg. 22. Examples should be given on how to evaluate.

S5C5i, pg. 25Allowable discharges include agricultural irrigation comingled with urban stormwater. Agr. has fertilizers and other contaminants. Why are discharges of this allowed? A Stormwater management employee explained that this refers to irrigation comingling with stormwater prior to use on fields. Ecology should clarify this in the document.

S5C7v, pg. 31. Why only 80%?

S5C7bii, pg. 33. There it is again with the 80%.

S5C7g, pg. 36. Are all these necessary? Seems like a lot of information gathering and recording.
