At the risk of sounding repetitive or redundant (I know these things have been said before) I will repeat anyway: there are some simple, basic & essential elements that should be included in the rule: Apply a 500 gal/day use limit for family (i.e. domestic) water consumption, and require metering to monitor that use.

Establish water efficiency programs (i.e. conservation) as the primary source for mitigating water use.

Use objective criteria to eliminate projects that are not fit for purpose; e.g. cost-benefit analysis, funding availability and likelihood for success.
