You will see my signature on another letter coming to you.

Herein I would like to add that nutrients can be highly decreased by the agency promoting alternative methods for dealing with sewage wastes.

Ecology should dissuade municipalities from land spreading and emitting effluents into water bodies. Different methods of handling sewage, such as high heat systems that either change this waste to a char or internally burn almost all the waste while sending that heat energy to the grid. Effluent toxins can be absorbed by plants and a variety of remediation techniques. Together, Ecology's urging of municipalities to adopt multiple non land spreading and non effluent emitting into water bodies methods will go a long way to reducing the nutrient problems.
