Many loads of asphalt removed from a WashDot project have been dumped at a number of locations on Whidbey Island. In one case, the material was dumped in a recent clear cut and may amount to just under 250 cubic yards or as much as 500 cubic yards. It is difficult to say.

Reading the proposed revisions, I cannot find anything that would prevent this dumping activity. How can the rules be written to stop this activity?

The only thing I can see to suggest is removing "asphaltic materials" from section (1) in Table 320-A.

I would like Ecology to consider if there is a means through the rules to address this situation.
