Good Morning Kristen,

I have been a Hanford site worker since 1993.

I have three questions:

- 1) How will Security be enforced regarding Hanford's Dangerous Waste? This permit modification request describes the security measures currently in place at Hanford for protection of the facility and in accordance with WAC 173-303-310, ..."prevent the unknowing entry, and minimize the possibility for the unauthorized entry, of persons or livestock onto the active portion of his or her facility."
- 2) What measures will be enforced to prevent acquisition of Hanford's Dangerous Waste? See above. Discussed content of the revised Attachment 3, to include signage, fencing, Hanford Patrol and Benton County Sheriff's Office roles.
- 3) When will the Yucca Mountain facility be completed so that the shipment of the High Level Waste can be safely shipped off the Hanford reservation? Explained to Mr. Stock that Yucca Mountain is currently not authorized as a waste repository and that waste from Hanford was not slated to be shipped there. Discussed the shipment of Hanford waste to the Waste Isolation Pilot Plant in New Mexico and that once Hanford is in the cue for WIPP that is where Hanford's waste meeting the WIPP Waste Acceptance Criteria will be shipped.
