First off, thank you for soliciting public feedback, and using that feedback to determine a best process go-forward.

As a local resident of Georgetown, and someone who takes environmental responsibility very seriously, I strongly advocate for continued clean-up and monitoring efforts. The Georgetown area has a poor record of environmental impacts, which has also spilled into the Duwamish River. Given your location and proximity to the river, it's critical that you continue to proactively pull and treat groundwater to prevent your prior contaminants from reaching the river and destroying a habitat that the community is currently trying to rebuild.

My ask is that you continue to support groundwater injections and treatment, in efforts to remove the remaining TCE/PCE/TCA/metals within the air, soil and groundwater in and around the particular site. Further, although no air contaminants were recorded in the recent testing, I would ask that these tests continue on an annual basis as part of a proper control mechanism. Especially given new injection methods being tried, it's critical to monitor appropriately.
