Clark County

(1) There is concern about the amount of time between the plan due date and the implementation date (only 6 months). There's 1 month for public comment, plus 6 months for Ecology review, and potentially longer due to the exception given to newly formed organizations. Much longer for any rejected plan resubmittals and reviews. Could this result in delayed implementation?

(2) Stewardship Plan Components (1)(j) Local Government Coordination. (ii) (A-C). What about collecting covered batteries within the stewardship program? Or is that information assumed to be the same as all the general collection sites?

(3) What is the due date for adding medium format batteries to the plans?

(4) Would an amendment to an approved plan be sufficient instead of submitting a new plan, for the addition of new covered batteries? Currently under Plan Submittal, Review, and Implementation: "(1)(a)(iii) When there is a need to include a type or format of covered battery that is not addressed in the plan last approved by the department." An amendment sounds reasonable for that situation.
(5) Plan Submittal Review and Implementation line (2)(d) - that statement doesn't fit in with that list.
