ALSO, when you consider projects that qualify for matching funds, PLEASE CONSIDER COMMUNITIES THAT MIGHT HAVE SERIOUS NEEDS FOR AIR QUALITY BUT NOT BE ABLE TO MATCH.

Work consistently with Washington States carbon emission reduction targets and other priorities.

Move toward a modern, zero-emissions transportation system. Thanks for prioritizing all-electric vehicles and public transit fleets.

Include Governor Inslees Executive Order 14-04 in the plan, which requires state agencies to include the cost of carbon emissions in cost-benefit analyses for public fleet purchases.
