What measures are being taken to ensure that emergency response vehicles and personnel (both fire and EMS) are adequate and prepared for a significant personnel or process event?

Will the facility support their own EMS and fire personnel? If so, will there be any mutual aid support given to the city or county? If so, how will this be coordinated?

Where is the nearest helipad and is it considered close enough to the facility for an adequate response time in the event of a significant injury?

If surrounding agencies will respond to an emergency condition at the facility, what is the plan to ensure they are aware of proper procedures around the facility's processes and machinery? This should be compared to industry best practice.

What percentage of facility personnel will be trained as first responders and/or first aid? This should be compared to industry best practice above and beyond WAC standards.

What effect will nighttime facility lighting have on the surrounding nocturnal wildlife and is the current proposed lighting of the best technology to best reduce glare, minimally impact area wildlife while maintaining adequate lighting for personnel and equipment moving around outside?

What is the procedure for operation/shutdown in the event of a blizzard or other natural event that prevents an on-coming shift from relieving the current shift? This procedure should be compared to best industrial practice to minimize effects on employees and emissions.
