However I think this country no longer needs to be in the mode of creating more jobs no matter what the cost. As a resident in the area, I want to say that we choose not to allow this type of damaging operation in our home. There is no reason to allow this organization to move into this area unless we can prove beyond a doubt that it would be disasterous. We need only say, "No, we don't want this here."
