PacWest proposes to use prognostic meteorological data, which is only acceptable whenever it is cost prohibitive or infeasible to collect adequately representative site-specific data. 40 CFR 51, App. W, § 8.4.5.1. It is neither cost prohibitive nor infeasible for PacWest to collect on-site data using EPA's Meteorological Monitoring Guidance for Regulatory Modeling Applications and the Ambient Monitoring Guidelines for Prevention of Significant Deterioration. How will Department of Ecology ensure the lawful and technically appropriate collection of meteorological data?
