Just some overall comments that we support ECY and the draft lines of the proposed language that you've put forward.

We appreciate provisions that are contained with respect to CRE, Commercial Refrigeration Equipment, that call for the transition dates and the effective date for the transition for our class of equipment. The labeling constructs both for refrigerants and for foam blowing agents and your willingness to align your language with other states who are attempting to put forward similar policies.
