Emissions from these sectors are potent and numerous. Gas that leaks from pipelines, manure and methane, and incomplete combustion products, as well as volatile organics from petroleum refinery plants, all need to be accounted Nitrous oxides are powerful GHG gases emitted form sewage treatment plants, application of sewage sludge and other sources need to be captured in the rule making process.
