AAA Washington supports reasonable, fair and effective means of preserving our environment, including those designed to reduce motor vehicle-caused pollution. - 1. Such efforts might include improving fuels and technology, warranties on emission systems, and inspection/maintenance programs if they are shown to be effective in reducing emissions.
