<b>acetaminophen</b> 500 MG tablet Commonly known as: <b>TYLENOL</b>	Take 2 tablets (1,000 mg total) by mouth every 8 (eight) hours
<b>azaTHIOprine</b> 50 mg tablet Commonly known as: <b>IMURAN</b> For diagnoses: <b>Status post kidney transplant</b>	take 1/4 tablet by mouth once daily
<b>calcitriol</b> 0.25 MCG capsule Commonly known as: <b>ROCALTROL</b> For diagnoses: <b>Parathyroid hormone excess</b>	Take 1 capsule (0.25 mcg total) by mouth every Monday, Wednesday, and Friday
<b>docusate sodium</b> 100 MG capsule Commonly known as: <b>DOK</b> For diagnoses: <b>Constipation due to pain medication</b>	Take 1 capsule (100 mg total) by mouth Twice a day
<b>gabapentin</b> 300 MG capsule Commonly known as: <b>NEURONTIN</b>	Take 1 capsule (300 mg total) by mouth Twice a day
<b>HYDROcodone-acetaminophen</b> 10-325 mg per tablet Commonly known as: <b>NORCO 10-325</b> For diagnoses: <b>Osteoarthritis, unspecified osteoarthritis type, unspecified site, Arthritis of right shoulder region, Degenerative arthritis of hand, Other chronic pain</b>	Take 1-2 tablets by mouth every 8 (eight) hours as needed for Pain
<b>levothyroxine</b> 150 MCG tablet For diagnoses: <b>Hypothyroidism, unspecified type</b>	Take 1 tablet (150 mcg total) by mouth daily
 <b>loperamide</b> 2 mg capsule Commonly known as: <b>IMODIUM</b> For diagnoses: <b>Nausea vomiting and diarrhea</b> Started by: Philip Ross, PA-C	Take 1 capsule (2 mg total) by mouth 4 (four) times daily as needed for Diarrhea
<b>morphine</b> 15 MG 12 hr tablet Commonly known as: <b>MS CONTIN</b> For diagnoses: <b>Chronic pain syndrome, Primary osteoarthritis of shoulder, Osteoarthritis of right hand, unspecified osteoarthritis type, Chronic bilateral low back pain without sciatica</b>	Take 1 tablet (15 mg total) by mouth Twice a day Swallow whole. Do not crush, break, or chew.
<b>multivitamin</b> capsule	
<b>naloxone</b> 0.4 mg/mL injection Commonly known as: <b>NARCAN</b>	Inject 1 mL (0.4 mg total) into the muscle once as needed (for opioid overdose) Inject in upper thigh or upper arm; may give in 2-3 min PRN
 <b>ondansetron</b> 4 MG disintegrating tablet Commonly known as: <b>ZOFRAN-ODT</b> For diagnoses: <b>Nausea vomiting and diarrhea</b> Started by: Philip Ross, PA-C	Take 1 tablet (4 mg total) by mouth every 8 (eight) hours as needed for Nausea or Vomiting

**predniSONE** 5 MG tablet

Commonly known as: DELTASONE

For diagnoses: History of kidney transplant

Take 1 tablet (5 mg total) by mouth daily

**tiZANidine** 4 MG tablet

Commonly known as: ZANAFLEX

Take 1 tablet (4 mg total) by mouth every 8 (eight) hours as needed
