

	levothyroxine 150 MCG tablet For diagnoses: Hypothyroidism, unspecified type	Take 1 tablet (150 mcg total) by mouth daily
ART	loperamide 2 mg capsule Commonly known as: IMODIUM For diagnoses: Nausea vomiting and diarrhea Started by: Philip Ross, PA-C	Take 1 capsule (2 mg total) by mouth 4 (four) times daily as needed for Diarrhea
	morphine 15 MG 12 hr tablet Commonly known as: MS CONTIN For diagnoses: Chronic pain syndrome, Primary osteoarthritis of shoulder, Osteoarthritis of right hand, unspecified osteoarthritis type, Chronic bilateral low back pain without sciatica	Take 1 tablet (15 mg total) by mouth Twice a day Swallow whole. Do not crush, break, or chew.

	naloxone 0.4 mg/mL injection Commonly known as: NARCAN	Inject 1 mL (0.4 mg total) into the muscle once as needed (for opioid overdose) Inject in upper thigh upper arm; may give in 2-3 min PRN
	ondansetron 4 MG disintegrating tablet Commonly known as: ZOFRAN-ODT For diagnoses: Nausea vomiting and diarrhea	Take 1 tablet (4 mg total) by mouth every 8 (eight) hours as needed for Nausea or Vomiting

Commonly known as: **DELTASONE**

For diagnoses: History of kidney transplant

Take 1 tablet (5 mg total) by mouth daily

tiZANidine 4 MG tablet

Commonly known as: ZANAFLEX

Take 1 tablet (4 mg total) by mouth every 8 (eight) hours as needed
