What type of outreach plan will they use? How will they ensure they are conducting culturally competent, inclusive outreach strategies?

Will they prioritize setting up accessible charging stations for low-income communities, and/or at their homes?

Another concern from one of my teammates is that these rules are heavily based on California's policy. Is there any evidence that EVs have been more accessible to low-income BIPOC people?
