There was evidence where a drone was used, and a contractor was used to do methane analysis, and their report showed exceedances in areas that Cedar Hills did not monitor. Yet, their quarterly reports for those same periods shows no exceedances. It's hard to trust self-monitored data. It would be nice if you could strengthen it and have at least one outside contractor come in, for at least for the large landfills like Cedar Hills. Thank you.
