There is an application for air curtain incinerators to process compost overs. Compost overs are in excess and a problem for composters trying to balance Nitrogen and Carbon ratios with the high amounts of feedstocks being generated for composting. Unfortunately, with the requirements of composters to accept curbside and food waste feedstocks, the compost overs typically have some waste comingled in the product. There should be an allowance for contaminants in compost overs to still be processed through an air curtain incinerator. An example would be that compost overs are allowed to be processed through an air curtain incinerator with contaminant less than 4% by weight.
