I am writing to urge you to NOT APPROVE more diesel generators at Sabey Data Centers in Quincy, WA.

Having any diesel generators at this point of our climate emergency is abominable. Adding more in Quincy, already disproportionately affected by pollution, is egregious! Our Climate Commitment Act, <https://ecology.wa.gov/air-climate/climate-commitment-act> states, "the Washington State Climate Commitment Act represents a comprehensive approach to tackling climate change through regulatory measures, financial investments, and a focus on equity, aiming to create a sustainable future for all residents."

Diesel emissions increases carbon dioxide emissions which decreases air quality affecting asthma sufferers and those with other respiratory illnesses.
