Please accept this email as the Washington Asphalt Pavement Association's (WAPA's) request for a public meeting related to the proposed revisions of the Air Quality General Orders. This request is made as instructed in the DOE's bulletin dated 06/02/2026.

WAPA is directly interested in the hot mix asphalt and rock crushing General Orders, but I'm confident that our members would also like to hear about the proposed changes in the concrete batch plants General Order.

As an aside, I'm interested in why the notice was not send to WAPA directly. We only found out about these revisions on 06/08/2026 when one of our members raised multiple concerns about proposed revisions in the General Orders. I will check our DOE contact request settings again, but we have never missed important DOE action notices in the past. I would appreciate it if you can provide any insight as to why WAPA was not on the mailing list for this critical DOE bulletin. We effectively lost a week of time to review and compile our concerns related to these General Order revisions and we would like to make sure we don't miss future bulletins.

If there are any "working notes" used to underpin the proposed revisions that WAPA can review before the public meeting, we would appreciate reviewing those notes as public comments are due only four days after the meeting.
