The Dept of Ecology should consider rejecting Sabey's Air Quality Permit. There are multiple data centers in the Wenatchee area, and the cumulative pollution is not being taken into consideration, and there is no real-time monitoring in place to ensure clean air for the residents of East Wenatchee.

Additionally, diesel generation should not be expanded as it is not congruent with WA state's Climate Commitment Act. The Dept of Ecology should require that Sabey Corporation consider alternative options, which are available and have not been presents by Sabey.

I am concerned about that data centers are significantly contributing to air and water pollution in our state, and the Dept of Ecology should beginning rejecting permits for data center expansion that do not use renewable energy.
