(2) For full accreditation, proficiency tests for potency, pesticides, and residual solvents must be in cannabis material containing concentrations of cannabinoids representative of products available to consumers.

My comments are in reference to Section 2 of 173-55-090 Proficiency Testing. This section requires clarification. Are you saying you want matrix-matched PT samples? If so, this seems unlikely. For most PT samples the matrix is hemp or hemp oil, or analytes in solution. Labs are not in control of producing proficiency tests and I doubt a true matrix-matched PT will be available when these rules are adopted. I recommend giving up on this idea of matrix-matched PT samples until they are widely available. Why is there a reference to only potency, pesticides, and residual solvents? What about mycotoxins, the micro screen, water activity, and terpenes?
