My comment refers to Table 2. Initial set of regulatory determinations for PFAS in products identified in our Chemical Action Plan and firefighting PPE. On pages 23-25. I believe that for the consumer products referenced in the table where the Draft Regulatory Determinations column reads Reporting Requirement, as in Chapters 1, 4-6, you change the Regulatory Determinations to include a requirement that the product be labeled as containing PFAS, a brief identification of what PFAS are and a brief summary of the health concerns. The public has a right to know of the public health concerns. Consumers should be trusted with this information.
