I worked as a technical writer on the original plan to move nuclear sludge on Tank Farm C from single-wall leaking tanks to new double-wall tanks. At that time, I suggested adding vitrification to the process, sealing the tanks in leaded glass that could have been obtained from then abundant CRTs and defunct televisions. That idea was rejected.

I think vitrification has been demonstrated in France to be a viable solution and should be incorporated at Hanford.
