Towards that end, Ecology's old, former SEPA guidance, there were two thresholds for a, below which, one which was...below which, you didn't have to look any further into analysis. Another one was where...set up a range by which you did a qualitative analysis of the emissions that would come from a project. While I don't support either of the numbers used there because I believe they were too low, that's a process Ecology should encourage, involve in this rulemaking process. Thank you.
