I think it's important that the Department of Ecology's new greenhouse role aid in emission reductions as that is intent of the Clean Energy Transformation Act, CETA. Emission reductions need to be below zero, not just net zero to achieve 100% clean energy by 2045. Also, I'm hoping that Ecology's greenhouse gas emissions standard is more stringent than the current one used by utilities in their integrated resource plans and take upstream and downstream emissions into consideration. If there are new standards that actually align with existing standards, we will not reach CETA milestones and they'll kind of be a waste of time. So that's it. Thanks so much.
