Sewage sludge, Biosolids class A, and Biosolids Class B should not be allowed to be spread across a community's watershed, land. Until biosolids are required to be tested for all regulated contaminants that get tested for in public drinking water, they should not be put on land. Contamination in biosolids will make their way to source water and most public drinking water supplies because conventional public water treatment facilities do not effectively treat for soluble contaminants.
