I would like to see this treated water returned to Lake Ravensdale (once it is safe) to support in-stream flows. These flows are critical to Lake Sawyer. Lake Sawyer's lake levels often drop over two feet each summer, leaving the lake inaccessible for some homeowners and inhospitable for fish and wildlife. If this flow were returned to the Lake and eventually allowed to flow into Lake Sawyer, this could help mitigate the impact of low in-stream flows.
