Solid waste for the Recycling Reform Act and these materials and components are solid and or semi-solid at room temperature.

Including household items and products and packaging such as

Tape,

Adhesives,

Duct tape,

Glue,

Resins that seal cardboard and fiberboard,

Binding agents,

Compound dyes and packaging,

Compound hennas and packaging,

Synthetic glues and binding sealants,

Silicon (sometimes spelled silicone),

Latex,

Wax (unused, and expired wax to be recycled) but used hair removal wax may include hair and hair focials which is bio-hazard waste/trash.

Soaps (semi-solid and solid soaps),

Detergents,

Lead glass (ex. Swarovski high-quality lead glass crystal)

Cubic Zirconia (synthetic diamond stimulant made from zirconium oxide.)

Leathers (textiles)

Sheep skins (textiles and unused gloves)

Charcoal and charcoal filters (Brita and hepa filters),

Lubricants (solid and semi-solid),

Aerosol WD40 cans,

Inhalers and parts and packaging,

Medication and vitamins pill packaging (plastic and aluminum films) if these do not qualify as medical waste and or bio-hazardous waste because there is no blood or bodily fluid contamination.
