Current cleanup only includes the parcels. It is extremely probably that the ground under W. Commodore Way is also contaminated based on history of other cleanup areas in Seattle. Will cleanup of W. Commodore Way take place. It is evident by the I-beams being placed in the ground that the South side of Commodore Time Oil property will be excavated out and that excavation includes the city right of way right up to the driving lanes.

Secondly, I fully feel BNSF should cleanup their portion of the property.
