- 1. Chevron Corporation made the mess they should clean it up.
- 2. Potential future use of the property as a restored estuary reconnecting the Edmonds Marsh to Puget Sound needs to be included in a revised feasibility study.
- 3. A more accurate cost-benefit calculation is needed.
- 4. Environmental hazards, especially from climate change and sea level rise, are required to be included in cleanup plan decision making.
- 5. Public Concern has not been properly weighted.
- 6. A cleanup plan between Alternative 4, complete excavation, and Alternative 6, no excavation, should be considered.
- 7. Tribal rights and interests must be included in the feasibility study.
- 8. Updated soil samples are needed before the feasibility study is completed.
