Hello, I would like to write to you in support of a permanent solution for contaminated soil and sediment at the former Rayonier Mill site in Port Angeles, WA. Proposed Alternative SL-3, leaving contaminated soil in place forever in a capped mound would greatly limit future development, and is unacceptable. It would leave a 10-acre, seven-foot-tall mound of capped toxic soil and sediment, surrounded by a fence, in perpetuity. The soil contains dioxins, PCBs, metals, diesel, and oil. This would greatly limit any future development in the area, and would conflict with the City's Comprehensive Plan for mixed-used development in the area. I would very much appreciate any efforts towards a full and permanent cleanup solution, including removing the contaminated soil.
