My expectations are that WADOE restore as much of the affected site to unrestricted use levels as possible. Consolidation and capping while well suited for some areas is concerning this close to the Strait of Juan de Fuca and the greater sound. I would prefer as much of the contaminated soil as practicable removed to a more stable and less sensitive area for long term disposition. It's important for the future of Clallam County and Port Angeles to have this high value piece of property useable for whatever future projects may come. That means restoring as much of the area to as clean of a standard as possible. By the 1990's we knew the hazards of many of the chemicals found on site. We need to hold Rayonier accountable.
