Please choose Option 5 to remedy the toxic Rayonier site in Port Angeles. The only right & just way forward, after these many decades of inaction, is to rid this shoreline area of toxic material once & for all. Any other choice involves the future uncertainties of sea level rise, earthquakes, or tsunamis disrupting the "pile & cover" option. If this site were not along the shoreline, there could be other safe options, but the nearshore is a particularly dynamic & vulnerable area, with a salmon stream that has been & could be again, very productive. Clean up & restoration of Ennis Cr must be total. The dock pilings & cement pad must be removed & the natural shoreline restored. Once cleanup is complete, the site should be left in its original, pre-mill state & become accessible to the public, some of whom have already died waiting for appropriate action. Thank you.
