Given the land alterations adjacent to Ennis Creek at the Rayonier site in Port Angeles, I encourage Ecology to include stream and estuary restoration as a requirement of site remediation. This is essential for the viability of fish populations of Ennis Creek.

Unless there is a planned owner and use for the pier, removal of the pier and hundreds of creosote pilings would be a good mitigation for other shoreline impacts that can not be mitigated.

Moreover, removal of contaminated soils seems the best option for site restoration and creation of a location where future development is not limited by past transgressions. I support the City of Port Angeles and many others who have recommended this action.
