Thank you for the opportunity to make a comment. We have had a well water analysis done by the Department of Ecology, United States EPA region 10, done on 6/12/2024. Results were sent to us from the US EPA signed by Jeffery Fowlow, and David Burford. Results show severe well water contamination with several PFAS contaminants. We are also receiving water from Culligan set up for us by the EPA (thank you).

I would like to point out that the area map for interim action does not include our location. We are north of the north border on Old Trails Rd. We have participated in the voluntary well testing and have shared our results with the EPA. How are these arbitrary boundaries being decided? We have several neighbors that have proven contaminated well water who are not in the interim action area per the map shared by the EPA.

We are requesting a point of entry system for our well, not an under sink 0.5 gallon per minute unit that does not address garden irrigation and watering of livestock much less general household needs. Pumping PFAS contaminated well water from almost 350 feet down and using it to irrigate (further contaminate the ground) does not help solve a worsening water contamination problem.
