We need to start raising food in our own backyard. Instead of going to Alaska, Canada, Chile, Norway, shetland islands, Scotland

we have got to start right here. I have been involved with the farming fish in Washington State since the 1989. We raised coho, steelhead in fact the same ones that this modification process at the Steiner site @ Bainbridge island, Atlantics. If we don't start

raising our own food then we will be subjects of wherever the food comes from. We have a processing plant here which employees

150 people, and the trucking to California, and Nevada, Arizona, and fishing farming itself. There a lot of spinoff jobs, the food for

the fish which comes from Canada, because we don't have a facility down here, the nets which come from Chile, and fish health,

marketing, hatchery down in Rochester, Thurston county and my own business, which takes smolts to the farm and harvests the

fish when they get to harvest size. I have 5 people that work on the Harvestor.
