The 2 proposed Memorandum of Understanding amendments are quite sensible. In regards to #2, clearly the MOU should abide by the Washington State regulation regarding those waters and not allow even advanced treatment sewage discharges in that key Puget Sound area. And Amendment 1 is a quite sensible no-brainer since obviously highly toxic smokestack scrubber waste should not be discharged into sound/ocean waters generally, and certainly must be prohibited in the key area being discussed due to listed species (under the Federal ESA) in that busy shipping area.

Please adopt these two amendments.
