Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the Concentrated Animal Feeding Operation (CAFO) General Permit draft permit. I urge Ecology to comply with the recent court order to implement reasonable, science-based protections for people, water, and aquatic life from pollution from CAFOs.

In the final permit, Ecology should at least make the following major changes:

- 1. Implement modern technologies to prevent leakage from waste storage facilities and lagoons.
- 2. implement stronger soil, surface, and groundwater monitoring requirements that will sufficiently detect pollution.
- 3. Safeguard against the overapplication of manure to land.
- 4. Implement meaningful discharge limitation standards and best management practices based on science (such as riparian buffers) to comply with water quality standards and keep our waterways fishable, swimmable, and drinkable.
