Please write the permits so that they have both the City of Spokane and Kaiser Aluminum testing the pollution coming out of the end of their pipes for PCBs using the best testing method called 1668c. Additionally both permits should require the facilities to test for PFAS. Both permits should be automatically re-written if the water quality standards for PCB's and/or the TMDL is finished by 2024. Please dismantle SRRTTF and require an implementation advisory committee of stakeholders when the TMDL is finished. Lastly, do not include mixing zones in these permits.
