Thank you for this opportunity to give comments. Here are mine:

- 1. Test at the end of outfalls; do not use "mixing zones" in the Spokane River.
- 2. Require DOE to declare that it will re-open and update when the TMDL is final and water-quality standards for PCBs are developed by the EPA in 2022.
- 3. The permits should require Kaiser and the City of Spokane to use Method 1668 consistently for testing at the ends of pipes.
- 4. Waive requirements that permittees be part of the Spokane River Toxics Task Force (SRRTTF). Create an advisory committee for the implementation of water quality upgrades instead.
