- -Clarify if jurisdictions can get credit for run-on to proposed new development treatment devices. Many times, these areas could be bypassed and if we can incentivize picking up additional area it could be very cost effective and beneficial to water quality.
- -Please clarify if a construction project has begun prior to June 30th and continues after June 30th date, would this count. We do not believe the language is clear.
- -Include incentives or bonus multipliers for utilizing SMAP proposed projects/ideas or implementing projects within the SMAP basins.
- -Propose incentives or bonus multipliers for collaborations between municipalities.
- -Can jurisdictions get credit for implementation of reimbursement programs on private property? Specifically, installation of rain barrels, rain gardens and permeable pavement projects reimbursed through a 'rain garden' program? These are private property retrofits that are beneficial to the MS4 by reducing peak flows and enhancing water quality.
- -Can jurisdictions receive credit for a programs that allocate funds to implement habit restoration of private property along water ways within their jurisdiction?
- -Do jurisdictions get credit for implementing an Urban tree sale program?
- -Do jurisdictions get credit for being a tree City USA City?
- -Do jurisdictions get credit for catch basin marking programs?
- -Under 'Non-Qualifying Project types', there is an incomplete statement: Mitigation projects otherwise required to compensate for problems caused by excessive
- -Do jurisdictions get credit under this program for habitat restoration and fecal field screening (for example) that we do to meet various TMDL requirements?
