

## Bonnie Blessing

Please show how the proposed wetland hydroperiod protections do not harm federally listed aquatic wildlife that occupy a narrow range of water depths.

In BMP T7.30 it states that when native wetland soils have adequate infiltration rates, bioretention can provide runoff treatment and stormwater runoff quantity.

Infiltration should not be allowed upstream of sensitive aquatic resources. Groundwater mounding can make infiltration basins fill up and send water downstream. Please show how preparing for more extreme events, applying more IID, developing programs to encourage veg and revising BMPs will not harm those downstream of infiltration basins especially after lowland rain on snow events.
