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No to Northwest Innovation Works (NWIW) Methanol refinery proposal in Kalama, Washington!

While the SEIS has made some necessary adjustments in the methane leakage rates, the rates continue to be low estimates given the widespread under-reporting of leaks.

However, even with the unreasonable assumptions about the single-sourcing of gas from British Columbia, as well as the unrealistically low leakage estimates for that source, the analysis confirms that NWIW's proposed facility would be enormously polluting.

The evidence in this draft SEIS demonstrates that Washington should deny NWIW's proposal to build and operate this dangerous methanol refinery in Kalama. We cannot keep building fossil fuel export infrastructure and expect to address the dangers of climate change.

Please keep our communities safe and keep Washington on track to meet our goals for reducing climate pollution.
