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A dam won't stop major flooding long- term, but it will destroy irreplaceable habitat. The DEIS clearly lays out the reality that this dam will have catastrophic impacts.

The Chehalis supports salmon, elk, birds, steelhead, lamprey, beavers, otters, entire food webs... all at risk.

This river carries cultural, ecological, and spiritual importance that a dam would violate.

Our community deserves real flood solutions, not a project that harms wildlife and wastes public dollars.

Restoring floodplains, strengthening local infrastructure, and investing in resilience are smarter, safer, science-backed options.
