The impacts of this project to anadromous fish would be significant: increased mortality of both downstream migrating smolt, upstream migrating salmon (envision near-death adult humans attempting to run up a steep stairway), increased piscivorous predation, increased water temperatures and reduction in sediment load carried downstream. Instead, remove structures from flood hazard zones, and tighten the permitting processes that allow such structures and uses in the first place.
